Essay Topic: Your thoughts on beneficial electricity.

Assignment:

Each student will create their own essay. Contestants should submit a 600-1000 word, typed, original, creative essay on the topic. Please complete the last page of this packet and use it as your cover page for your essay. Please do not put your name on any part of your essay, only on the cover sheet. The essay should be in length and focus on this year's topic as well as your knowledge about the 7 Cooperative Principles. The 5 finalists will have the opportunity to have a face to face interview with the selection committee before the final decision.

Essays must be received in the 4 Rivers Electric office by 4:30pm Wednesday, Jan. 22<sup>th</sup>, 2020.

Eligibility:

High school juniors whose families have an account in the 4 Rivers Electric service territory. Students must provide their cooperative account number with application.

How essays will be scored:

- 1. Knowledge of subject
- 4. Composition
- 2. Originality
- 5. Grammar
- 3. Content (ability to adhere to topic)

Before being sent to the final judges, essays will be judged by teachers and professors experienced in the fields of English and writing.

How do I become a finalist?

After all essays are turned in, they will be given to the preliminary judges who will review and judge the essays. Judges will assign each essay an independent score; each judge's scores will be combined for a final essay score. The top 5 essays scores will become the finalists. Each finalist will be invited to an interview at the 4 Rivers Electric office Feb. 13<sup>th</sup> 2020.

How is the interview scored?

There will be 3 or more non 4 Rivers Electric employees who will be conducting interviews. During the interviews they look for the following criteria:

- Knowledge of the electric co-op
- Community involvement
- Maturity/personal accountability and conduct
- Enthusiasm for the opportunity
   Note there is no basis on GPA or financial need

How are winners chosen?

Each finalist's essay scores will be combined with the interview scores to create a final contest scores. That final score will determine the 3 winners; winners will be announced immediately following interviews.
