ENTIRE SERVICE TERRITORY

4 Rivers Electric Cooperative, Inc.'s (Cooperative's) Bylaws, Rules and Regulations are supplemental to this tariff and are incorporated herein.

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NON-COMMERCIAL SERVICE

APPLICABILITY:

Applicable to all single-phase farms and residential consumers, water wells, churches, schools, community halls, and other public buildings located within the Cooperative's service territory. The service may contain only one (1) single-family dwelling, subject to the Cooperative's rules and regulations.

TYPE OF SERVICE:

Single-phase, 60 hertz, at available secondary voltage.

RATE:

Customer Charge	\$48.25 per Month
Plus:	\$1.00 per kVA of transformer capacity in excess of 15 kVA -Not including shared transformers
Energy Charge	
First 1,000 kWh per month	\$0.1241 per kWh
Over 1,000 kWh per month	\$0.1141 per kWh

POWER COST ADJUSTMENT:

Energy sold under this schedule is subject to the Power Cost Adjustment clause on file.

MINIMUM CHARGE:

The minimum monthly charge under the above rate shall be the Customer Charge per month. No kWh's are included in the minimum charge. If revenue derived from or the duration of the prospective service is not of sufficient term to warrant the investment based on the minimum bill as determined by the Line Extension Policy, the cooperative may require an adequate minimum monthly bill calculated upon reasonable consideration before undertaking to supply service.

TERMS OF PAYMENT:

In accordance with Cooperative's Rules and Regulations.

CONDITIONS OF SERVICE:

1. In the event a consumer orders a disconnection and reconnection of service at the same location within a period of twelve (12) months, the Cooperative may collect as a reconnection charge the sum of such minimum bills as would have accrued during the period of disconnection.
2. Motors having a rated capacity in excess of ten horsepower (10 hp) must be three-phase unless specifically authorized by the Cooperative. If three phase power is required, the applicable commercial rate tariff would apply.
